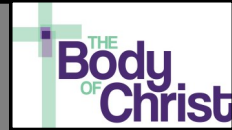
K-GROUPS have kicked off to a great start! We have some amazing groups this semester. It's a great way to get to know your PoP family. Sign up for one today!
