

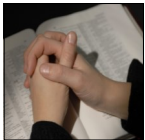

VOTER'S MEETING RESULTS. Last week, the voters' assembly decided to expand our Christian school, which is expecting a record high enrollment in the coming school year. The voters approved a plan to divide into three classrooms instead of the current two. So next school year

there will be preschool, kindergarten, a classroom for grades 1-2, a classroom for grades 3-5 (this is the new one), and one for grades 6-8. The voters also approved adding another full-time teacher to our staff. The current plan is to extend a divine call to a graduate of our church body's teacher training college, Martin Luther College.
