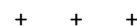

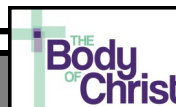
"I Believe" | Midweek Lenten Worship | Thursdays 7:00PM

This year we are reviewing who our God is and what he does for us, using the Apostles' Creed as our guide. All are invited to come to this extra time spent with God's powerful Word, 7:00-7:45 each Thursday evening in Lent.



Next Sunday, we listen in as Jesus tells his disciples about his upcoming suffering, death, and resurrection. Jesus has to clarify for those who follow him that the way of the cross is not only the way that *he* will walk, but also the way that *we* will walk.
