weekend. The Thursday service is a shortened version of the upcoming Sunday's service.

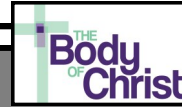
AIDE POSITION OPEN: We have an afternoon aide position open for the upcoming school year. If you are interested in this position, please speak to Mr. Sell for more details.
