**NEXT SUNDAY, VOTER'S MEETING—12PM.** The topic will be our elementary school ministry. In February the voters decided to set the dollar amount of support that our school will receive from the general PoP budget in the coming fiscal year. The goal for our school was to cover their budget using these funds from the PoP general fund and income from student tuition. A target date of April 30<sup>th</sup> was set to see how much income from tuition was projected for the coming year, and if a shortfall of income was expected, then the voters would be presented with ways of making up the difference. As of April 30<sup>th</sup>, projected income was short of the goal, so we will meet to discuss plans to address the situation. In the meantime, please pray for our leadership team and school board as they work to propose ways of going forward. Pray also for our school faculty, staff, students and families as they continue to work in this valuable part of our ministry.
