THE CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS SERVICE is Sunday, December 16th. This year's service is a cantata—the children sing the entire service (no individual parts). Practices are taking place during Family Bible Hour. **A CD is not available, so it is important all parents have children here every Sunday if they want them to be part of the service.** Two Saturday practices will be: December 8 and 15 from 9:30-11:00AM (note: these 2 practices are not enough time for children to learn the songs).
