THRIVENT MEMBERS. Thrivent has sent all their members a letter indicating if they qualify to receive any new Thrivent Choice Dollars. These dollars can be designated to Prince of Peace. Both our church and school are eligible to receive these dollars, at no cost to the Thrivent members. If you haven't received a letter, please check online. PoP is eligible to receive up to \$1000 if all Thrivent members here designate our church or school ministries.
