WEDNESDAY: NEW BIBLE CLASS—Lost in Translation? Have you ever looked at different translations of the Bible? Ever been amazed at how many there are? We'll take a look at some challenges in translating the Bible, and we will also actually look at many Bible translations of some key verses. Our goal is to appreciate how God brings his Word reliably to us in our own language, and also to appreciate the difficult work of translating the Bible accurately and understandably. We meet in the school library at 7PM each Wednesday.

THURSDAY: MIDWEEK WORSHIP—6:30PM. This service is a preview of the upcoming Sunday and is especially intended for those unable to attend Sunday worship.

THURSDAY: CHOIR. Has God blessed you with musical gifts? Our adult choir (open to high school students also)

sings about once a month from September through May, building up worshipers with the Word and helping people praise God. We rehearse in the chapel after Thursday worship service ends. Come give choir a try. **Our first choir practice is this Thursday, September 6th at 7:15PM.**

FRIDAY-SATURDAY: MEN'S LEADERSHIP RETREAT-- Men of PoP are invited to a Leadership Retreat next weekend, September 7-8 (Fri-Sat) at East Canyon State Park, north of Park City. **While we especially hope that elected leaders of PoP will attend, the retreat is open to all men of the congregation.** Friday evening will be a time of fellowship but the heart of the retreat will be God's Word and our interactive Bible studies on Saturday. Although the retreat runs both days, you are welcome to attend just Saturday (Bible Studies are from 9AM to 3PM—bring a Bible and something to write with). Sign up on the bulletin board if you are coming and there is also **a sign-up sheet to bring items for Saturday's breakfast and lunch.** Friday campers need to bring firewood, camping gear and their own food for Friday dinner.
