Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten Supply List

- A bag <u>or</u> backpack to bring to school every day
 (Please try to avoid the smaller size back packs. Although they are cute and more preschool size, it's really hard to fit a folder and a project inside.)
- 1 folder with pockets
- 6 small size glue sticks (Elmer's brand please)
- 1 bottle of white Elmer's school glue
- 1 box of Tissues
- 1 package of Baby wipes not disinfecting
- 1 tub of Clorox wipes disinfecting
- 3 boxes of CRAYOLA 24 count crayons.
- 1 3 ring binder, 2 inch (plain front any solid color)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 extra set of clothes, including underwear and socks, to be kept at school. Please put the clothes in a zipper plastic bag with your child's name on it. They will be kept in the bathroom cupboard.

*Please write your child's name on their backpack and folder.

* All other school supplies will be used for the preschool and "shared" for

class use.

Extended Care Supply List

Also, if your child is staying for Extended Care and is in Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, or Kindergarten and will be here past 12:00:

- a cold lunch (We are not allowed to cook or heat up food for your child. If you want them to have it warm, you may send it in a thermos.)
 foldable, plastic nap mat (no larger than 2' by 5')
- 3. pillow and blanket (optional, will be stored with their nap mat)
- Please note that the storage area for your child's nap things is an area 12 inches wide by 12 inches high by 18 inches deep. Please ensure that all things brought for nap can fit when folded within these dimensions.
- All soft nap items (pillows and blankets) must go home weekly to be washed.
- Nap time is not mandatory. However, the rule is that children must let their friends that want to sleep, sleep.

12 traditional #2 wooden pencils, sharpened

1 bottle of school glue
2 pocket folders with brads in the middle
1 scissors
1 ruler, standard <u>and</u> metric
1 compass, one that has an adjustable knob would be best
1 protractor
1 calculator (basic is tine for 6 th grade, scientific is recommended for 7 th & 8 th)
3 <u>Wide-ruled</u> spiral-bound notebooks, 8" x 10½"
2 Packs Wide-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper, 8" x 10½" (Please keep in a folder, not a binder.)
Hymnal (New students will be given a Hymnal if they don't already have one. Returning students are asked to bring the Hymnal that was used last
year.) If needed, hymnals may be purchased for \$25.
NIV Bible (All new students in grades 1-8 will be given a New International Version 2011 Bible If needed, additional Bibles may be purchased for \$15.
2 tissue boxes
plastic spoons to share with classroom (about 100 count)
plastic forks to share with classroom (about 100 count)
100-200 paper plates to share with classroom (9 inch and not Styrofoam)
1 roll of paper towels
1 container disinfecting wipes for the classroom (You may send more if you would like.)
1 packet of lined index cards
A packet of post-it-note flag markers
