# Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten

(These name brand or off brand items are required.)

- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 2 containers of cleaning wipes (Lysol or off-brand)
- 1 bottle of pump hand sanitizer
- 1 one inch binder with clear pocket on front (write your child's name on the inside) If your child attended last year, please bring back their binder from last year.
- 1 extra set of clothes (just in case; shirt, shorts/pants, underwear, and socks)
- 1 2-pocket folder to go back and forth daily
- 1 12-count box of colored pencils (classic or bold colors, Crayola or off-brand)
- 1 24-count box of crayons (classic colors, Crayola or off-brand)
- 9 monthly snacks\* that can feed 24 students (total of 9 months—may be brought in monthly)

\*Please note that we cannot serve anything perishable or that contains peanuts. Check the ideas below for suggestions, but you are not limited to just these ideas.

**Please keep snacks sealed in original packaging.**

Also, if your child is staying for Extended Care and is in Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, or Kindergarten and will be here past 12:00:

1. a cold lunch (We are not allowed to cook or heat up food for your child. If you want them to have it warm, you may send it in a thermos.)
  2. foldable, plastic nap mat (no larger than 2' by 5')
  3. pillow and blanket (optional, will be stored with their nap mat)
- Please note that the storage area for your child's nap things is an area 12 inches wide by 12 inches high by 18 inches deep. Please ensure that all things brought for nap can fit when folded within these dimensions.
  - All soft nap items (pillows and blankets) must go home weekly to be washed.
  - Nap time is not mandatory. However, the rule is that children must let their friends that want to sleep, sleep.

# KINDERGARTEN

*If a specific brand or count is noted, please do your best to purchase that exact item. Thank you.*

- ❑ 12 traditional #2 wooden pencils, sharpened
- ❑ 1 large pink eraser 
- ❑ 1 box of **24 Crayola** crayons 
- ❑ **2-3 boxes of Crayola 8 or 10 wide and WASHABLE classic color markers** 
- ❑ 1 **Crayola 8** color watercolor paint set 
- ❑ 10 glue sticks
- ❑ 2 4 fl. oz bottles of School Glue
- ❑ 1 blunt scissors 
- ❑ 1 plastic pencil box (8.5 x 5.75 x 2.5) 
- ❑ 2 pocket folders w/o brads in the middle
- ❑ 1 wide-lined spiral bound notebook, 8" x 10½"
- ❑ 1 backpack (*large enough to carry an 8 ½ x 14 folder and a few other items such as a lunchbox, sweatshirt, etc.*)
- ❑ 1 box of tissues (at least 180 count)
- ❑ 2 containers of disinfecting wipes (any brand) 
- ❑ 1 container baby wipes (any brand) 
- ❑ 2 large unopened boxes/packages of healthy snacks that keep (ex. wheat thins, fish crackers, pretzels, fruit snacks, etc.) (*Additional snacks will be requested throughout the school year as needed.*)
- ❑ 1 box of about 100 snack size Ziploc bags (any brand) 
- ❑ 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags (any brand)
- ❑ 1 roll of paper towels
- ❑ A smile! 

**\*Please send school supplies to school in a bag/Ziploc bag, not a pencil box.**  
*Certain items will be put in a community supply.*

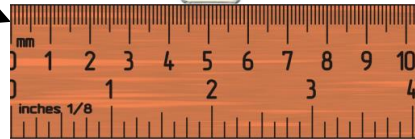


# Grades 1-2



**Friendly reminder: Please label all supplies with your child's name or initials.**

- 1 backpack
- 1 regular size (8"x 5"x 3") pencil box
- 24 or more traditional #2, wooden pencils, sharpened (NO mechanical pencils)
- 3 pink erasers
- 2 boxes 24 Crayola crayons
- 2 boxes 8-10 Crayola washable, wide, markers with these traditional colors: (red, orange, green, yellow, blue, purple, black, brown)
- 2 boxes colored pencils
- 1 Crayola washable watercolor set
- 6 clear-dry glue sticks
- 2 pocket folders w/o brads in the middle
- 1 pair blunt scissors
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters
- 2 Wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- Plastic spoons (about 50 count)
- 1 box of tissues (at least 180 count)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Ziploc bag with U.S. coins: 25 pennies, 8 nickels, 10 dimes, 6 quarters

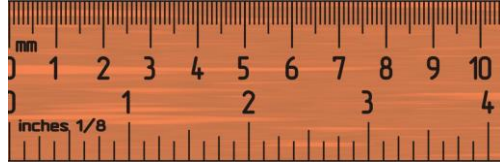
## Activity Book (optional)

# Grades 3-5

- 6-12 #2 Wooden Pencils, Sharpened
- 1 Highlighter
- 1 Box of Crayons- at least a 24 pack
- 1 Box of Markers
- 1 Box of Colored Pencils
- 1 Plastic Pencil Box
- 1 Glue Bottle
- 1 Glue Stick
- 1 Scissors
- 1 large plain pink eraser
- 1 Ruler, Standard and Metric
- 2 Pocket Folders with brads in the middle
- 1 Compass, one that has an adjustable knob would be best (grades 3-5) →



- 1 Protractor, a small plastic one would be best if you can find one (grade 5) →



- 1 Basic Calculator (grades 4-5)
- 2 **Wide-ruled** spiral-bound notebooks, 8" x 10½"
- 1 Pack **Wide-ruled** loose-leaf notebook paper, 8" x 10½"
- Hymnal (New students will be given a Hymnal if they don't already have one. Returning students are asked to bring the Hymnal that was used last year.)  
If needed, hymnals may be purchased for \$25.
- NIV Bible (All students in grades 1-8 will be given a New International Version 2011 Bible this year.)  
If needed, additional Bibles may be purchased for \$15.
- 1 Box of tissues (at least 180 count)
- 1 Roll of paper towels
- 3 Containers of disinfecting wipes (You can send more if you would like.)



# Grades 6-8

- 12 traditional #2 wooden pencils, sharpened
- 5 red pens
- 1-2 highlighters
- 1 big eraser
- 1 box of crayons (24 count is good)
- 1 box of wide markers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 bottle of school glue
- 4 pocket folders w/o brads in the middle
- 1 scissors
- 1 ruler, standard **and** metric
- 1 compass, one that has an adjustable knob would be best →



- 1 protractor, a **small** plastic one would be best if you can find one →



- 1 calculator (basic is fine for 6<sup>th</sup> grade, scientific is recommended for 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>)
- 4 **Wide-ruled** spiral-bound notebooks, 8" x 10½"
- 4 Packs **Wide-ruled** loose-leaf notebook paper, 8" x 10½" (*Please keep in a folder, not a binder.*)
- Hymnal (New students will be given a Hymnal if they don't already have one. Returning students are asked to bring the Hymnal that was used last year.)  
If needed, hymnals may be purchased for \$25.
- NIV Bible (*All students in grades 1-8 will be given a New International Version 2011 Bible this year.*)  
If needed, additional Bibles may be purchased for \$15.
- 1 tissue box
- plastic spoons to share with classroom (about 100 count)
- plastic forks to share with classroom (about 100 count)
- 100-200 paper plates to share with classroom (9 inch and not Styrofoam)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 3 containers disinfecting wipes for the classroom (You may send more if you would like.)

**\*\*Note:** You may want to buy extra pencils, red pens, lined paper, etc. to keep at home if your child traditionally runs out of/loses supplies mid-year.
