## 10 for 10 : OPEN HEARTS (Sacrificial Giving)

This weekend is the third of a three-week stewardship emphasis titled Ten for Ten.

The Lord speaks to us about worldly wealth and possessions over 2,300 times in his Word. Two weeks ago, we heard that the Lord asks, without apology, to be first in our hearts. The Lord's position in our heart is to be reflected in our firstfruits giving. Last week, we considered the matter of proportional giving. What percentage of the Lord's blessings do we really need to live on? This week, our series concludes by examining what God has to say about sacrificial giving.

These biblical accounts of sacrificial giving are another one of God's blessings to us. May we hear them, be inspired by them, and—as God gives us opportunity—make them our own story!

### Some encouraging words and stories from fellow believers here:

*God knows my heart, tithing helps me to know where my heart is. -Member of PoP*

*"It's not about me." I'm not sure when exactly this sunk in. Maybe it was opportunities I had to serve underprivileged. Maybe it was just serving others in general, but at some point, it really sank in. I could have a nicer car, a fancier place to live, a bigger tv, more toys, etc., but it's not about me. It's all about Jesus. It's about the souls he loves who are lost and need to be reached. It's about the souls he loves who know him and need to be nurtured. It's always about others and, more importantly, it's always about Jesus and his work. So, I forego some of the things I could have in order to give because I can't take those with me, but I can help make sure those souls are singing Jesus' praises with me eternally. Because, in the end, it's all about Him. -Member of PoP*



*My parents were great models of both ordinary and extraordinary giving. Though I never knew how much money my father made, I always knew that 10% of it went straight to Church. Beyond that, I saw them give time and money repeatedly to many in need. When I got my first real job and first real paycheck, I should've known exactly what to do. Oddly, I had a lot of good reasons why I couldn't tithe "just yet." It was not until I was married and encouraged by my husband to set those excuses aside (even in our early very lean years together) that regular giving became an ordinary part of life for me again. There was no "aha moment," but through the ordinary discipline of regular tithing God quite literally changed my stingy heart, and then slowly and miraculously allowed me to see what a gift and privilege it might be to give beyond that. -Friend of PoP*

*A long time ago, my wife and I had a small apartment, a 10-year old car, my student loan to pay back, my wife's tuition and books, income taxes, and other living expenses. How much would we be able to contribute to our church? My \$685/month salary and a small income from my wife working odd jobs hardly covered our expenses. This was before personal computers and Excel spreadsheets, so we used an envelope system as a budgeting tool. Each month, we would divide our incomes into labeled envelopes: rent, food, gasoline, utilities, church and miscellaneous, and hoped there would be no surprise expenses.*

*We were not pleased with the amount of our church offering and tried to come up with a way to increase it. What worked for us was to give a major portion of every pay increase that we would receive to our church, eventually surpassing 10% of our income. Our Lord does not tell us how much to return to him, only that it should be freely given from our hearts. 10% seemed like a reasonable goal. This procedure worked well for us. Normally, pay increases are received for overtime pay, promotions, cost of living adjustments (COLA), etc. As our children grew, we tried to instill in them that they should set aside at least 10% of their babysitting, paper routes, yard work income, no matter how big or small, to be returned to our Lord. After all, everything belongs to him anyway. -Friend of PoP*

I am not commanding you, but I want to test the sincerity of your love by comparing it with the earnestness of others. For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich.


